The Incredible Story of our Resident: Jennifer Roberts

Jennifer Roberts was born on 16th February 1936 in Shanghai. Her early childhood, particularly the first four years, was a privileged one as the firstborn child of expatriates living in China at the time.

In 1940, Jennifer and her family were forced to leave Shanghai just before the arrival of Japanese forces. They left behind many treasured possessions and boarded one of the last passenger ships to pass through the Suez Canal before its closure for the remainder of the war.

Upon arriving in England, the family settled in Dorset, near Jennifer's maternal grandmother, while her father was stationed elsewhere until the war ended. In 1943, her sister Carolyn was born, and shortly after, the family moved to Waltonon-Thames. Jennifer and Carolyn attended school in nearby Weybridge.

After completing her schooling, Jennifer spent time in Switzerland at finishing school, where she became fluent in French. On her return to England, she pursued a foundation course in Art at Guildford, which led to her first role at Asprey's on Bond Street in London. At that time, Asprey's had an interior decorating department, and Jennifer greatly enjoyed assisting clients with decorating choices for some of London's grandest homes.

In 1959, Jennifer married her husband, Kenyon, at St Erconwald's Church in Walton-on-Thames. Kenyon had trained at the Royal College of Music and built a successful career working with ITV in its early days, composing music for advertising and BBC drama throughout the 1970s and 1980s. The couple set up their home in West Byfleet, where they remained for many years.

had three children: Lucy, Tim, and Peter. The family only moved once a couple of years before Kenyon's death in 1998 from prostate cancer at the age of 75.

While raising her children, Jennifer took on various roles, including working in a local restaurant and a China shop. Later, she secured a position with a company transporting shipping containers across the Irish Sea. This role required frequent travel, including visits to transport managers across the South East and research trips to seaports. Despite the challenges, Jennifer excelled in this role.

Today, Jennifer's daughter Lucy lives in Worcestershire, has four grown-up children, and works part-time as a specialist in the treatment of problem scars. Tim works in risk management for a large building society and lives in Hertford, while Peter is a designer based in Central London. Her sister Carolyn is now retired and resides in Odiham, Hampshire.

Jennifer has been an active member of the Catholic Church throughout her life, including leading her parish's flower arranging group for many years. Her faith remains deeply important to her. Classical music was ever-present in the Roberts household, with every family member playing an instrument. Jennifer also maintains a deep appreciation for the Royal Family and beautiful things, and she continues to find immense joy in reading newspapers and magazines.



Team Recipe: Grace Palmers's

Varilla Cupcakes



30 mins

INGREDIENTS

Vanilla cupcakes x12

- 220g softened butter
- 220g golden caster sugar
- 4 eggs
- 5 teaspoons vanilla essence
- 5 teaspoons
- 220g self-rising flour

Butter cream

- 500a softened butter
- 1 teaspoon vanilla essence
- 300g icing sugar
- 3 tbsp milk

METHOD

For the cupcakes:

- 1. Heat oven to 180 c
- Whisk softened butter and golden caster sugar together until smooth, then add in the eggs, vanilla essence self-raising flour and bicarbonate
- 3. Continue to whisk all together till the mixture is smooth
- 4. Then spoon into your cupcake holders
- 5. Bake for 15 mins until golden brown

For the butter cream:

- Whisk softened butter, vanilla essence, icing sugar, and milk together
- 2. When the cupcakes cool down you, can decorate with the butter cream








Spreading Festive Cheer in Our Community
